How to participate in the Backpack Auction...

1. Review the auction items in this catalog. Items are divided into sections: Camps, Classes & Lessons, Parties & Family Fun, For the Grown-Ups, Claypit Hill, Happy Hollow, and Loker.
Catalog pages are double-sided.
2. Choose the item(s) on which you would like to bid.
3. Write your best and final bid(s) along with your contact information a) on the Bid Form on this catalog's last page, b) via the online form, or c) by email (see below for details).
4. Sign and return your form to your child's school's Backpack Auction/PTO Drop-Box, submit your bid(s) online at <https://goo.gl/forms/vUAKNhoCpLabs7du2> please feel free to use the online form more than once if needed), or email your bid(s) to BackpackAuction@gmail.com by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 9, 2017.

Auction FAQs...

Is there a minimum bid?

Most teacher items have a minimum bid of \$25.00. Any other items with a minimum bid will be specified in the item description.

Can I team up with someone else to increase the amount of my bid?

Absolutely! There are many items that specify they are for the winner and a friend or for a group. Feel free to team up with others who are also interested in an item to increase your bid and increase your chances of winning (keeping in mind the number of participants specified in the item description). *Only one person should submit the bid.*

Should I even bother to bid on items? What are my chances of ever winning anything?

Yes, you should definitely bid if you are interested in an item, and every year is different. An item may receive multiple bids one year and one or even no bid the next year. Any bid is welcome - our goal is for all items in the catalog to be bid on!

When are bids due?

BIDS ARE DUE BY 5:00 P.M. ON THURSDAY, MARCH 9, 2017

When & how will I find out if I have won?

Winners will be notified via email by **Monday, March 13, 2017** (this is the reason we need your email address - please make sure it is legible when submitting paper bids). You will NOT be notified if you do not win.

When is payment due for items I've won?

Payment is due no later than **Monday, March 20, 2017**

How do I pay for the items I win?

We are able to accept payment by check or credit card (via PayPal - a PayPal account is not necessary). Checks should be made payable to Wayland PTO, placed in an envelope to the attention of "Backpack Auction Payment", and dropped in the PTO mailbox at your child's school. To pay by credit card via PayPal, go to www.waylandpto.org/backpack-auction and follow the directions there. If we do not receive payment by **March 20, 2017**, we will send one reminder. If after the reminder we do not receive payment by **March 24, 2017** the Auction Committee reserves the right to award the item to the next highest bidder.

How will ties be handled?

If there is a tie on an item, each family will be contacted via email by **March 13, 2017** and asked to increase their bid. If we do not hear back from you within 48 hours, you will be taken out of the running. The highest re-bid will win.

How do I find out more about the items before I bid?

Please use the internet to research auction items. Many of the donors have included their websites.

How do I get more information if I win?

Once payment is received, the Auction Committee will contact each winner with more details about the item(s) won.
