

For 25 years, the **Wayland Public Schools Foundation (WPSF)** has supported our schools by funding teacher-led classroom innovations and creative units of study not covered by the regular school budget. This year, in addition to providing funds for Smart Classrooms at all grade levels, the WPSF provided tools and materials to maintain and enhance the organic gardens at Claypit and created an "instrument bank" so that all elementary school children can have the opportunity, regardless of cost, to learn an instrument if they desire.
