|    | <b>Backpack auction</b> ( <i>winter</i> fundraiser): Collect donations for auction items, create and distribute the catalog, and manage the online bidding process. A fun way to have a huge impact for the school and PTO!  | 2 co-chairs   |

|  | <b>Claypit Cares:</b> Help build a community service tradition, where each grade completes a hands-on community service project to help others in our class, school, town, state, country and world. Coordinate with the Claypit Cares committee to plan and run the event in <i>June</i> .  | 1 co-chair and grade level committee spots                  |
|  | <b>Communication (board position):</b> Help inform and excite families about PTO events/initiatives by coordinating updates for the school's eblast, updating the Facebook page, designing the seasonal newsletter, offering advice and other ideas.   | 1 board role  |
|  | <b>Grade level community building co-chairs (K-2):</b> Create opportunities to build a sense of community within your grade. When it is safe to plan events, coordinate 1 family gathering and 1 parent gathering of your choice   | 1 co-chair each for kindergarten and 2 <sup>nd</sup> grades |
|  | <b>Harvest Festival:</b> Help run a <i>fall</i> festival with hands-on seasonal crafts/projects to kick-off the fall book fair   | 1 co-chair, committee spots available                       |
|  | <b>STEAM Discovery Night:</b> Continue to build this new <i>winter</i> tradition, which includes student science displays and interactive science exhibitions  | Committee spots available                                   |
